## Enter Data

- Threading, treadling, tie-up, dents, and color.

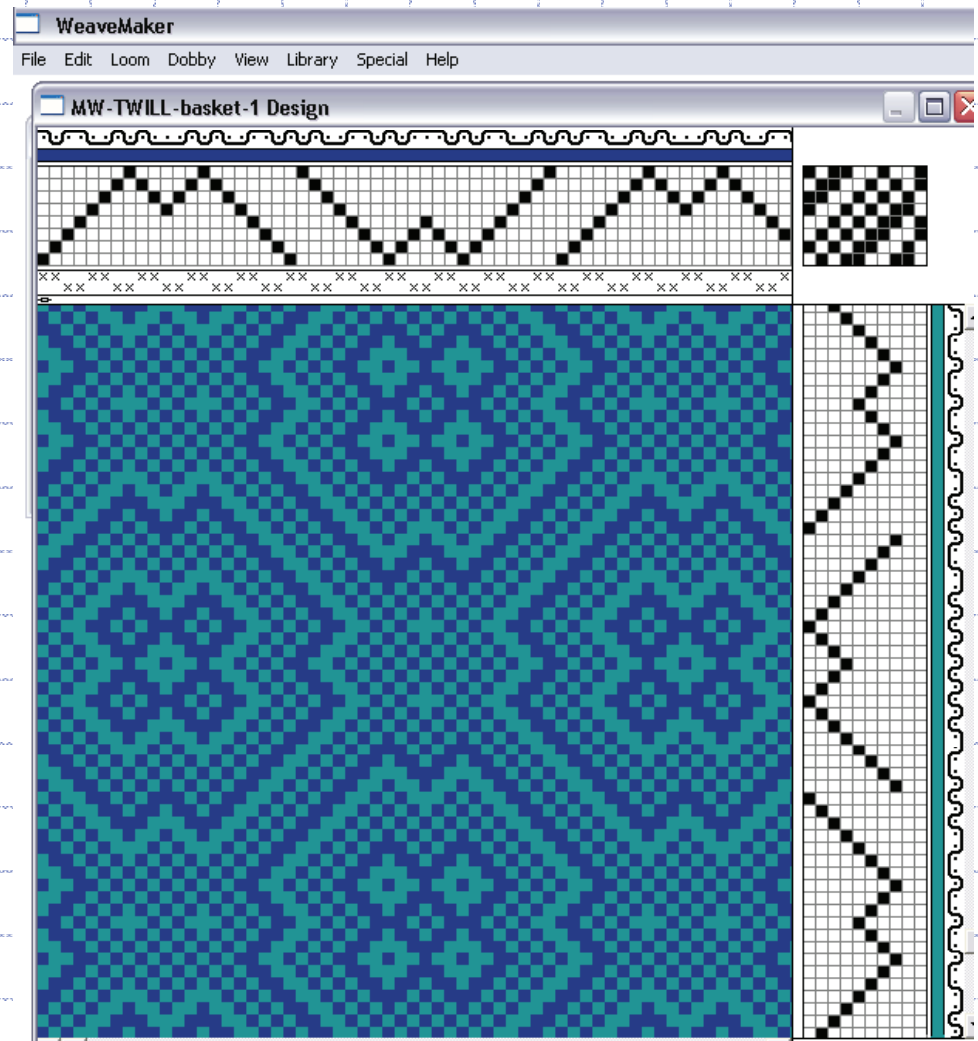
#### Questions:

- ◆ Insert/ Delete keys will insert/delete ends, picks, treadles. (Yes/No)
- ◆ Blank ends, picks, and treadles are allowed. (Yes/No)

- a. Line/Freehand
- b. Algebraic

- f. Treadle as Drawn In
- g. Add Tabby

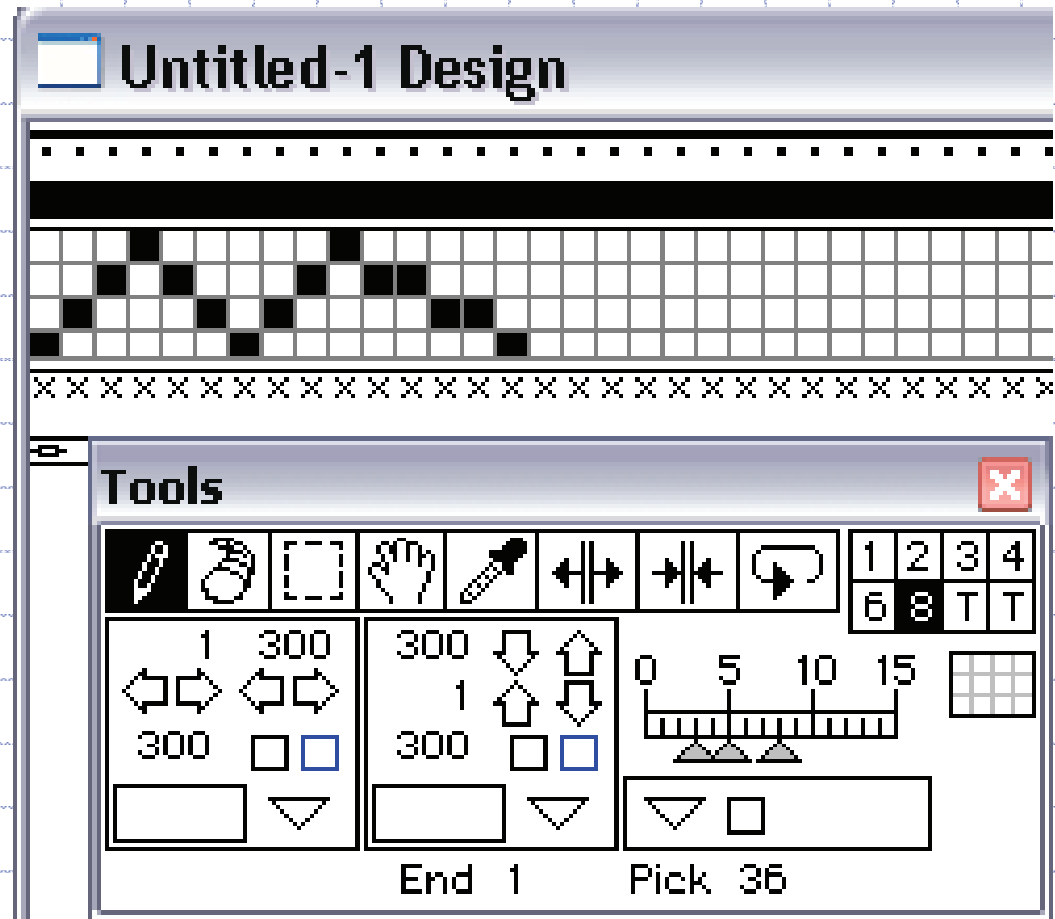
# WeaveMaker

## a. Line Draw

Use pencil tool to click and drag a line between two points  
Works in threading, tieup and treadingling.

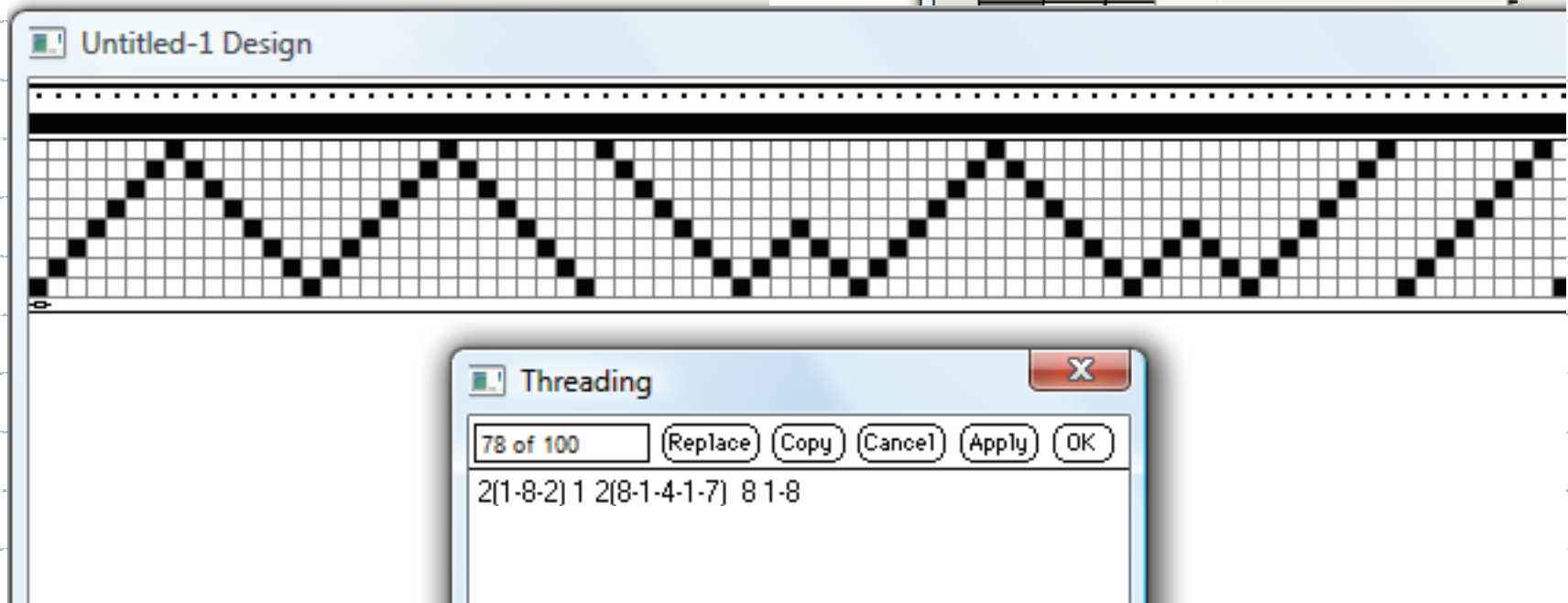
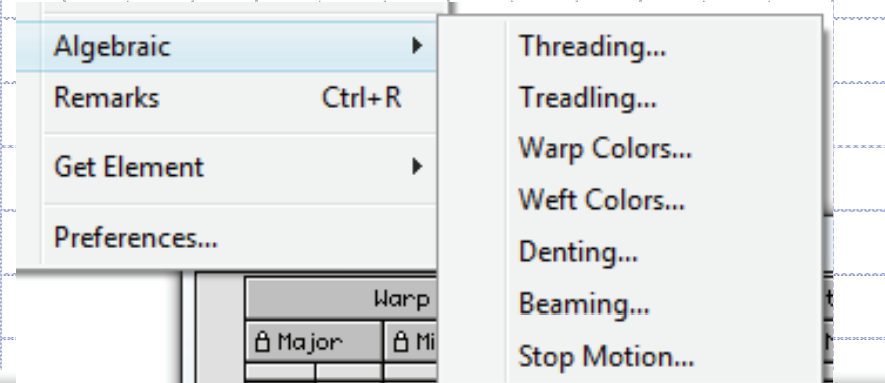
## Freehand Draw

Change the pencil under  
Edit → Preferences



# WeaveMaker b. Algebraic

Enter several draft components numerically.  
See example below.

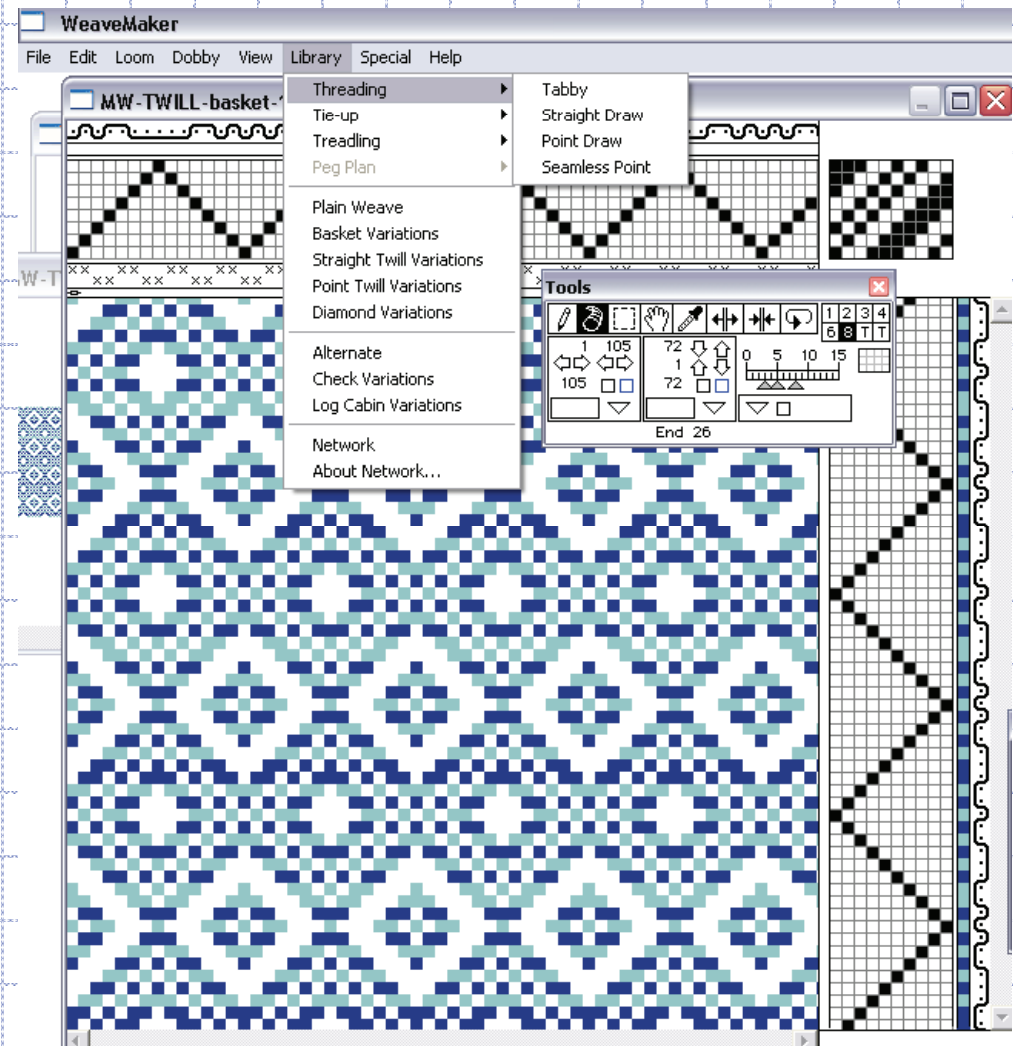


# WeaveMaker

## c. Library and Cornucopia

Fill with preset draft elements.

Cornucopia generates design elements.

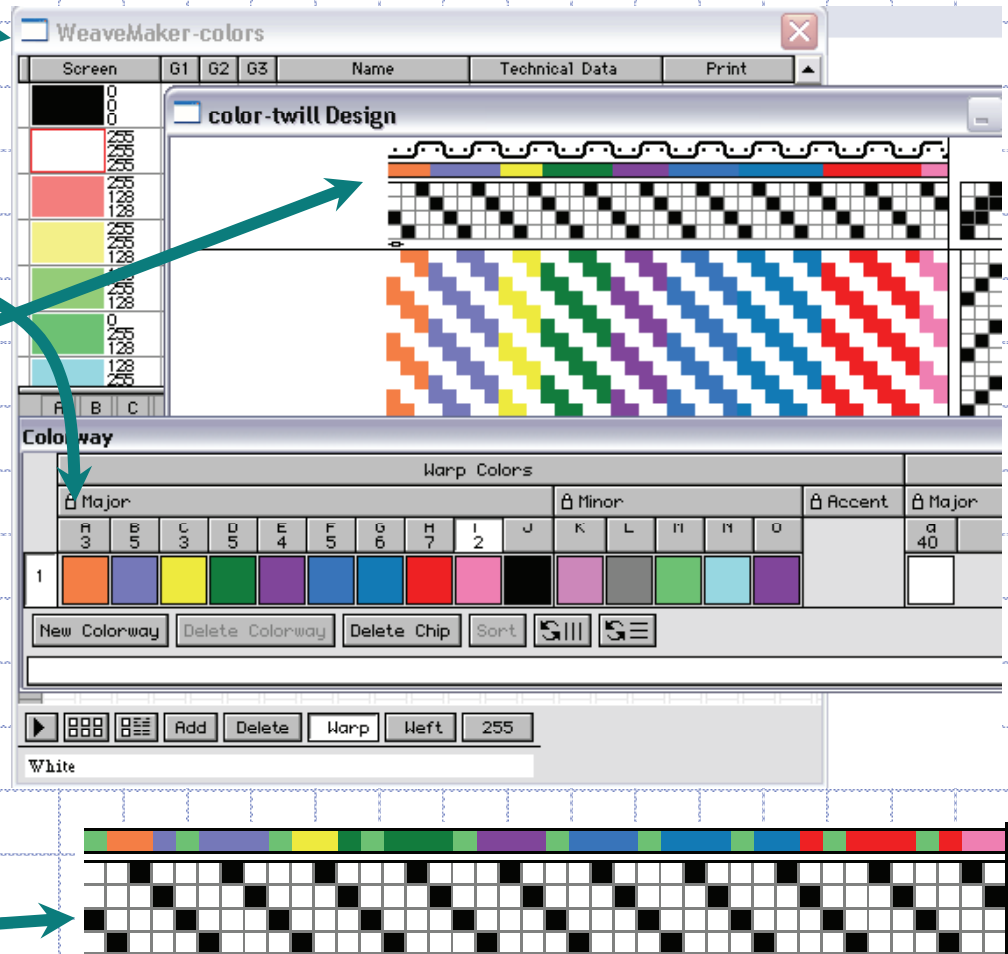


# WeaveMaker d. Color

Create Color Palette and add colors to Colorway.

Use pencil tool to place color in the color bar.

Or use pencil tool to click on a shaft and change all threads to new color. Here shaft 2 was changed to lime green.



# WeaveMaker e. Colorway

## Colorway

Use multiple colorways to design different versions of the same draft.

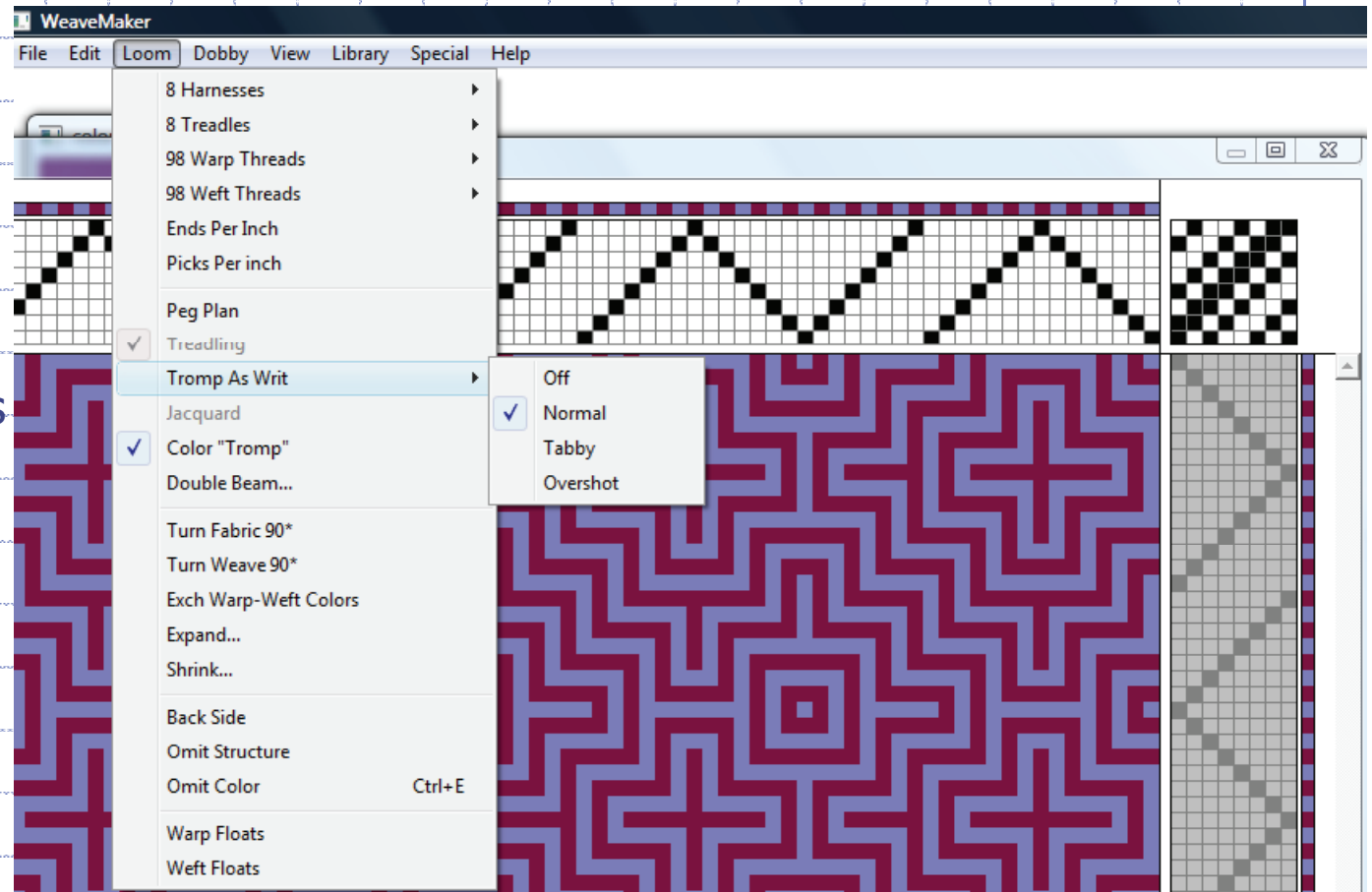
# WeaveMaker

## f. Tromp as Writ

When Tromp As Writ is on the weft data is entered as you enter the warp data. The grey treading is for a reminder. Loom → Tromp As Writ → Normal Color "Tromp" for color

→ Tabby  
adds tabby to draft  
→ Overshot  
Block order and tabby

Exch Warp-Weft Colors  
Copies weft colors to  
the warp.





# WeaveMaker

## g. Add Tabby

Using the Loom → Tromp As Writ → Tabby will add tabby for many types of drafts. See f.

Use Loom → Expand to insert places for the tabby picks.

For other designs, you can interleave two treadlings. See <http://www.weavemaker.com/1/faq/faq.php#3> for detailed instructions. One of the treadlings should be tabby.
